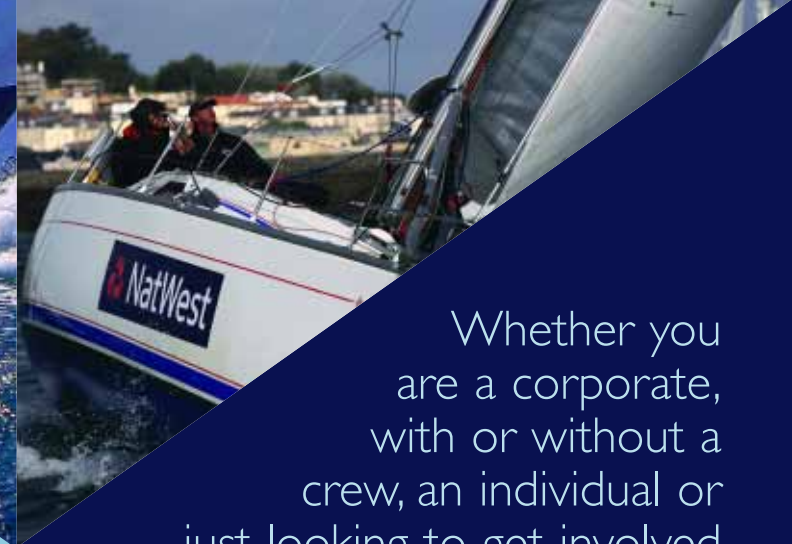

Yachts, legs and crews - what are the options?

All yachts are supplied with highly skilled and experienced skippers and first mates, although you can provide your own first mate providing they are suitably qualified and experienced.

You can also volunteer to join the crew on one of the charity yachts. Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis and volunteers will be expected to fund the cost of their travel and incidental expenses.

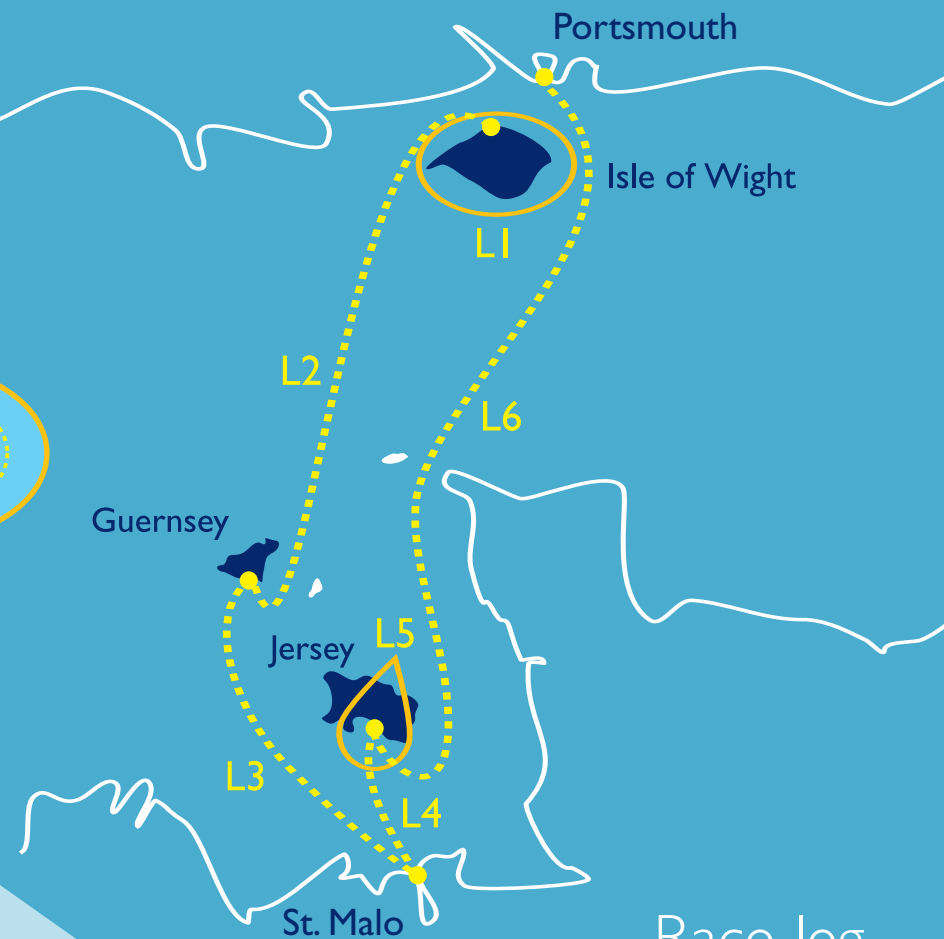
